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“Extremely URGENT”

CEs / SEs / EEs to note

1. Hon’ble Chief Minister is holding a review meeting of Secretaries on drinking water issues (among other things) in connection with floods at 9.30 AM on 16.8.18.
2. Later Hon’ble Minister for WR will hold a VC at 10.30 AM on 16.8.2018 (KSITM VC). All regional CEs/ SEs / EEs to attend the VC from their respective District Collectorates.
3. The District Administration is overwhelmed with rescue and relief operations. Govt desires that KWA raises to the occasion and coordinates water supply issues at the district level. At the District level a ‘Water Team’ shall be constituted to assist the District Administration.
4. The District Level Water Team shall consist of the following officers
 - i. Nodal Officer (KWA Official – team leader)
 - ii. JS (Disaster Management), Collectorate
 - iii. SS/JS, Office of the Deputy Director, Panchayaths
(Nodal Officers shall proactively coordinate with DCs and get (ii) and (iii) nominated for the said purpose)

The following KWA officers are nominated as Nodal Officers District-wise. They shall lead the ‘water team’ at the District Level for co-ordinating the activities.

5. The Nodal officers of KWA shall:

- a) Form and head the team comprising of JS from Disaster Management of the Collectorate and JS / SS from O/O DD, Panchayat (the KWA, HO has taken up the matter with DCs)
- b) Identify the areas affected by drinking water scarcity in the district
- c) Map deficient areas to functional WTPs that can spare treated water (even across district boundaries if needed)
- d) Work out patent access routes by road/ water to reach the above problem areas and plan strategies to provide water in the affected areas from the nearest operational WTPs through tankers / other feasible options based on requirement
- e) Work out approximate requirement of tankers. The list of tankers capable of transporting drinking water with contact No.s can be obtained through Disaster Management Section of the Collectorate /GPs (who have a list used in summer months) and should be updated. (Establish contact with the tanker operators in advance).
- f) The quality of water supplied should be ensured. Ensure **superchlorination** and sufficient residual chlorine.
- g) Direct EEs / Subdivision AxEs who shall earmark responsible officers for each area (and work out a fail-proof line of command).
- h) Use of Kiosks established in drought be examined.
- i) **CEs to supervise the entire planning and execution of the above.**
- j) **Nodal officers shall plan as above and share [(a) to (g)] with Head Office by 8 AM on 16.8.2018. CEs should ensure that emails are received in time. The details are to be shared with Government (WR), Hon'ble Chief Minister and Hon'ble Minister WRD at 9AM on 16.8.2018.**
